Lesson Focus and Goals:

To generate inspiration from found objects

Learning Aims and Objectives:

Structure/Activity:

9.30am - Introduction	Welcome, aims and objectives.
9.32am	Task 1 – Participants will choose an object from the 17 items given that they feel best describes themselves and their personality. They will be given 2 minutes to find the object. They will then feedback within 3 mins as to why they have made their choice and introduce themselves. This introduction will include their name, what they teach and what is their practice.
9.37am	Task 2 – They will work in twos to receive peer support, and they will discuss how they can use the objects chosen to inspire them within their own practice. Participants will be given questions as prompts. They will have 4 mins for discussion and 5 mins to feedback. An example will be given.
9.46am	Participants will be asked to reflect and share what they have learnt from the tasks to assess learning.
